

## Little People and the ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act)

This session is dedicated to Title I of the ADA in employment for persons with disabilities. We will also discuss some employment cases related to little people and the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the Arizona Office of Civil Rights.

He has also been published in several journals and the Montana Law Review on disability and technology issues.
