Mr. Towle has worked in the aviation industry for over 22 years, including over 14 years with the Federal Government. Just a few weeks following the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, Mr. Towle was hired as a Security Inspector with the FAA in Denver, and transitioned to TSA as an Inspector in 2002. He spent the next 8 years with TSA at Colorado Springs working in various positions, including Assistant Federal Security Director of Inspections, Stakeholder Manager, and Assistant Federal Security Director for Screening Operations. In 2010, Mr. Towle transferred to Phoenix as a Program Analyst, and in 2011 was promoted to the position of Stakeholder Manager, where he serves as the primary liaison between TSA's leadership and key stakeholders at the airport as well as organizations throughout the community.
